The National Agreement between the NPMHU and USPS is set to expire on November 20, 2011. Negotiations over the terms of a successor agreement began on August 30, 2011. Since that time, the parties have been meeting to exchange and discuss concepts and proposals for possible inclusion in a new collective bargaining agreement.

In an effort to keep the NPMHU membership informed as the negotiations process unfolds, the National Office has been distributing periodic Contract Update bulletins. Copies of these updates

have been mailed to each NPMHU officer and representative, for posting on union bulletin boards in postal facilities across the country.
