## Memorandum of Understanding

The parties agree that the National Postal Mail Handlers Union, a Division of the Laborers' International Union of North America, AFL-CIO will be joining the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, the National Association of Letter Carriers Union, AFL-CIO and the United States Postal Service on the Employee Assistance Program Committees at the National and District level effective upon the signing of this Memorandum of Understanding. The parties further agree that Advisory Committee members are appointed by their respective national union representative serving on the National Joint Committee. Each organization is entitled to two voting members and two alternates on each of the district advisory committees. Both voting and alternate committee members will attend the meetings. The position of chairperson should rotate among the four represented organizations.
